



## French Language Proficiency Assessment Resources

Any prospective French American School of Denver student in grades 3 through 8 wanting to enroll and be admitted will need to demonstrate some level of French language proficiency. Students applying for grades 3 through 8 must pass a language proficiency assessment at grade level in order to be accepted.
